



EXHUMATION OF GRAVES AT BLOCKS 23, 24, 25, 26, N-429, N-1-1 AND N-1-2

WITHIN CHOA CHU KANG MUSLIM CEMETERY (PUSARA ABADI) [PHASE 10]

The National Environment Agency (NEA) conducts regular exhumation programmes at Choa Chu Kang Cemetery to ensure sustainable land use for future burials.

Muslim graves at Blocks 23, 24, 25, 26, N-429, N-1-1 and N-1-2 will be exhumed after the registration closing date (please refer to

location map). The exhumed remains will be reinterred at Choa Chu Kang Muslim Cemetery. NEA has appointed Majlis Ugama Islam Singapura (MUIS) to carry out the registration, verification, exhumation, shrouding and reinterment services for the Phase 10 exhumations.


PRINCIPAL GRAVES

Family members are encouraged to claim the remains of their Next-of-Kin (the "Principal Deceased") buried in these blocks of the cemetery. The claim period will be one year, from 10 June 2025 to 9 June 2026. The Government will bear all exhumation and reinterment costs. For Principal Graves, if a written objection is submitted to MUIS from any family member and cannot be resolved, the claim will be voided and the deceased will be exhumed as unclaimed (meaning the exhumation will proceed without a family claim).

SUPPLEMENTARY GRAVES

Family members may also claim remains of other deceased family members (the "Supplementary Deceased") buried within Choa Chu Kang Muslim Cemetery outside of Blocks 23, 24, 25, 26, N-429, N-1-1 and N-1-2 who are related to the Principal Deceased so that the remains from the same family can be reinterred in the same or adjacent grave plots. The Supplementary Deceased must meet the **minimum burial period of 15 years** prior to the registration closing date.

Supplementary Deceased must be related to the Principal Deceased in the following manner:



- For each registration of Supplementary Grave, a non-refundable fee of \$80 (before GST) per grave will be charged. Should any family member submit a written objection to MUIS regarding the registration or exhumation of a Supplementary Grave, the
- registration will be cancelled, and the exhumation will not proceed. Family members must produce a Death or Burial Certificate to register for Supplementary Graves. Alternatively, they may obtain a burial extract from NEA's Choa Chu Kang Cemetery Office for a fee of \$20 (after GST).


Old Choa Chu Kang Road

HOW TO MAKE A CLAIM

REGISTRATION AND VERIFICATION OF GRAVES

- From Tuesday, 10 June 2025, 9.00am, Claimants are encouraged to register online using Singpass via the website www.pusara.sg to claim for the remains of their Next-of-Kin (NOK). For Claimants who are unable to register online, appointments can be made via the website to visit the Muslim Cemetery Exhumation Office (MCEO).
- Required documents for registration: Claimant's NRIC, Death or Burial Certificate, and where applicable, a Written Authorisation from biological family members (for Principal Graves only). Supporting documents, including legal documentation for adopted children, are required where applicable. Claimant is responsible for obtaining agreement from all family members and relatives before proceeding with the claim.
- Claimant is to verify the principal grave to be claimed online when submitting claims online. Claimants are to make an appointment for physical verification of graves, if required.
- Claimant who has submitted a claim online for a principal grave, may wish to claim for a supplementary grave by submitting he form in-person at the MCEO with t
- 6. Upon successful online registration, the main Claimant will receive an acknowledgement via email and SMS. The application will be processed, and the Claimant will be notified of the exhumation date later.
- Claimant must notify MUIS in writing of any changes to their address or contact number. Registering early does not guarantee an earlier exhumation date, as the schedule of exhumations is determined by
- operational needs. All claim registrations must comply with the prevailing **Terms and Conditions*** for grave exhumation as stipulated by NEA and MUIS.
- *The Terms and Conditions are available on the website 10. Visits to the MCEO are by appointment only. Please book through the online registration system or call 6238 4504. Note: Priority will be given to Claimants with appointments over walk-in Claimants.

- Claimant will be notified via email and SMS later on the exhumation date. Claimant and relatives should inform MUIS if they wish to witness the exhumation, fully or partially. If unable to attend,
- Claimants may authorise other family members or MUIS to act on their behalf through a Written Authorisation. For any changes, please notify MUIS at 6238 4504 or info@pusara.sg, at least two weeks before the scheduled exhumation.
- During exhumation, the grave will be dug to the original soil depth (liang lahad) to retrieve remains. Any remains found will be shrouded in white cloth and reinterred. If no remains are found, a token amount of grave soil will be collected for reinterment. No special prayers, such as Talkin (brief reminder), will be conducted for the exhumed remains, as there is no religious requirement.
- Exhumed remains will be reinterred at Choa Chu Kang Muslim Cemetery on the same day of exhumation. Claimant will receive a reinterment document from MUIS detailing the new grave block and plot numbers. The remains will be reinterred according to **NEA's guidelines***:
- 8 remains per crypt for claimed graves 16 remains per crypt for unclaimed graves
- (*) subject to the sizes of the remains
- To reinter remains outside Singapore, please inform MUIS and you must obtain a Coffin Permit from NEA. The permit costs \$17.50
- (inclusive of GST). The coffin is to be hermetically sealed. Submit your application to NEA at: Port Health Office

UNCLAIMED GRAVES

All graves will be exhumed, and the remains reinterred at Choa Chu Kang Muslim Cemetery. The exhumation process will be supervised by MUIS.

NEA will maintain all reinterment records in their database.
